The Sapphire Priming solution is a treatment used for optimizing papers for the HP Indigo commercial presses such as 5000 and 7000 series. The treatment is based on the application of a water-soluble polymer. For this reason, it is important that substrates treated with Sapphire, and not intended for immediate printing, are stored in a vapor barrier wrapping paper and away from light. A maximum shelf life of 6 months, before printing, can be expected for this type of storage.
